

Angela Criswell, A certified prevention specialist, joined the Lung Cancer Alliance in January 2015 as a Field Coordinator for the Kentucky LEADS Collaborative, a partnership between LCA, the University of Kentucky, and the University of Louisville to advance Lung Cancer Education, Awareness, Detection and Survivorship. Prior to this new professional endeavor, Angela served as Tobacco Prevention and Cessation Program Manager for the KY Department for Public Health. Her passion for substance abuse prevention and public health, however, originated in work focused on the prevention of underage drinking, adult high risk drinking, and drunk driving. From 2009 to 2012 she worked for the Bluegrass Prevention Center, coordinating the Alcohol Prevention Enhancement Site and providing statewide technical assistance to Kentucky's network of community mental health centers and substance abuse prevention boards and coalitions; from 2004 to 2009 she served as the State4 Executive Director for Mothers Against Drunk Driving in KY.
